

## Number Swaps



The children are organised to stand or sit in a circle and each child is given a number, e.g. *Number one, Amy. Number two, Martin, etc.*

One person is asked to stand in the centre (the facilitator for the first few rounds until the children become familiar with the activity) and this person calls out any two numbers (but none higher than the numbers given to the children in the circle).

The children who have these numbers then swap places.

If the person in the centre calls out 3 and 7, for example, 3 and 7 quickly swap places.

At the same time, the person in the centre must try to occupy one of their vacant places.

If s/he succeeds, the player who now has no place in the circle goes to the centre and calls the next two numbers.
